DON'T PUNISH THE TRUTH TELLERS WHO EXPOSED THE WAR CRIMES COMMITTED IN OUR NAME AND PAID FOR WITH OUR TAX DOLLARS.

Julian Assange and Chelsea Manning are in prison while those who ordered the crimes, committed the crimes, and covered up the crimes, are walking free.

NYC Free Assange demands freedom for award-winning publisher and journalist ***Julian Assange*** and courageous whistle-blower ***Chelsea Manning***. Assange has published nothing but the truth and Manning has disclosed proof of U.S. war crimes. Assange, an Australian citizen, is being held in the Medical Ward of Belmarsh Prison in the UK. The US is demanding his extradition to face 175 years in prison. The US government has imprisoned Julian's source, Chelsea Manning, to try to force her to testify against Assange. Now, ***Jeremy Hammond***, imprisoned activist, has been called against his will to testify before a grand jury in the Eastern District of Virginia, likely the same one investigating WikiLeaks and Assange adding a year to his 10-year sentence originally scheduled to end within the year. He will refuse to testify.

The New York Times co-published the Afghanistan and Iraq War Logs in 2010, in collaboration with ***WikiLeaks***. It partnered with WikiLeaks again in publishing the Collateral Murder video which exposed the crimes committed against innocent civilians, intentionally killing children and journalists in our name and with our tax dollars. NYT journalists who worked with Assange, including Mark Mazzetti, Jane Perlez, Eric Schmitt, Andrew W. Lehren, C. J. Chivers, Carlotta Gall, Jacob Harris, Alan McLean ...are now in the crosshairs.

Rather than defend Julian Assange, *The New York Times* became a vehicle for the dissemination of baseless attacks on Assange, attempts to destroy him, and threatening all whistleblowers and publishers of the truth.
